Since 2018 Tampere has been known as the Sauna Capital of the World. This status is based on the high standard of our saunas and the fact that Tampere is home to the majority of public saunas in Finland. The history of the sauna culture in the city goes back to the oldest public sauna still functioning: Rajaportti Sauna in the district of Pispala, Tampere.

There are over 50 public saunas in the region where you can relax all year round. We indulge those who love hot steam and ice-cold water, as our region offers plenty of possibilities to enjoy this addictive combination. Rajaportti

which the Finnish Heritage Agency is preparing protection by special legislation.
