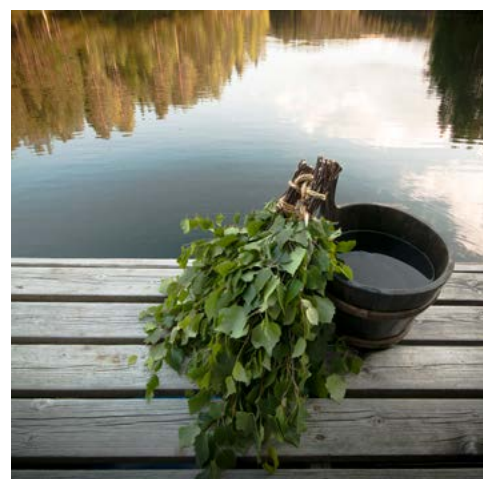

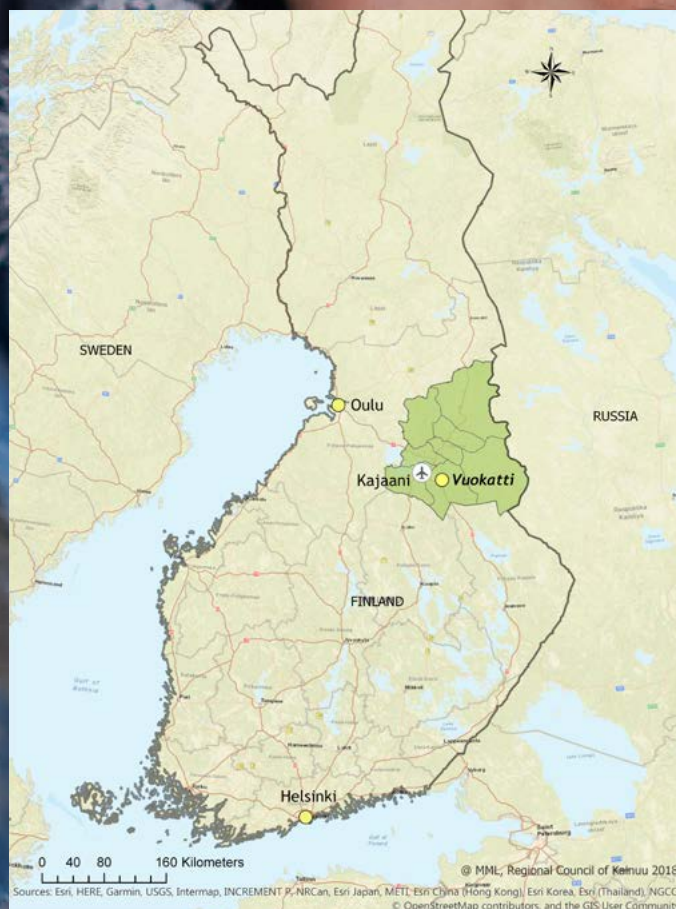
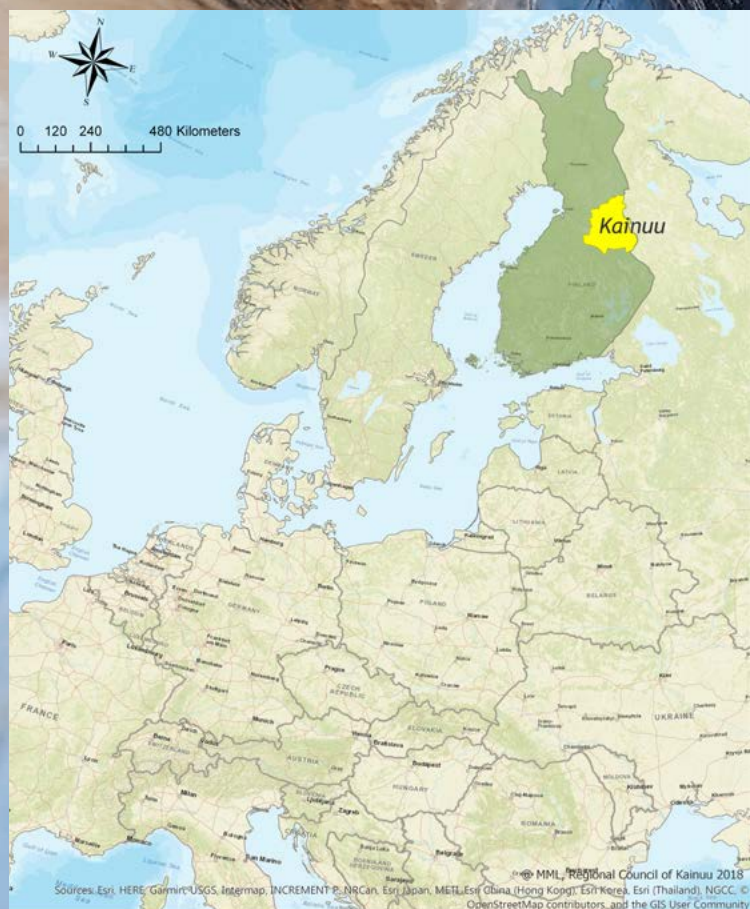

Accessibility

The **nearest airport** is situated in Kajaani (KAJ) approximately 40 km from Vuokatti. There are 2-4 daily flights in from Helsinki (HEL) to Kajaani operated by the national carrier Finnair. The flight time is 1 h 20 min. There is a shuttle bus service connecting Vuokatti and the airport. The driving time is 40 min. International car rental companies have also their service point at the airport of Kajaani. Airport shuttle A. Kyllönen: www.akyllonen.fi/airbus

The nearest **railway station** is situated in Kajaani, approximately 35 min. from Vuokatti. There are a few daily trains connecting Kajaani with Helsinki (6 h via Lahti, Kouvola, Mikkeli and Kuopio) and Kajaani with Oulu (2 h). From Kajaani there is a local bus connection to Vuokatti (travel time approximately 1 h). Please note that there are seasonal changes in the bus timetables.

VUOKATTI

VUOKATTI - THE BEST MIXTURE OF THE FINNISH EXPERIENCE

Vuokatti is one of the most popular all year round holiday resorts in Finland and it is especially favoured by those who want to spend an active nature holiday in an authentic Finnish atmosphere. Situated in the Arctic Lakeland, just in the middle of the country at the crossroad of Lapland and the Lakeland district, Vuokatti and the surrounding area in the province of Kainuu offer visitors a mixture of the highlights of the best Finnish experience in one package.

The landscape of Vuokatti is a combination of hills and lakes and vast forest areas. The highest point on the Vuokatinvaara hill is at the level of 326 meters which maybe sounds modest, but the view opening from this point is breathtaking with large lakes and wilderness. It is often quoted as one of the national landscapes of Finland and was earlier depicted also on the 500 FIM banknote.

There is a dense well kept and marked net of skiing and hiking routes (150 km) around the resort of Vuokatti and the Vuokatinvaara hills. These routes are easily accessible from all the accommodation facilities and enable everybody to discover and enjoy the arctic nature. In wintertime 32 km of the the skiing tracks are illuminated. Thanks to the fact that Vuokatti Sport is the Olympic Training Center for the Nordic skiing disciplines the cross-country skiing tracks are always kept in ideal conditions not only for the professionals but equally for the leisure travelers.

DIVERSE OFFER OF ACTIVITIES BOTH IN SUMMER AND WINTER

Vuokatti is the best cross-country skiing resort in Finland and the outdoor skiing season always starts on the 10th of October at 10am no matter what the weather outside is. 50,000m³ snow made by snow-cannons during the previous winter and carefully stored during the summer season is the secret to the early opening of the skiing season. Depending on the development of the weather the first skiing tracks grow gradually and reach at the peak season the length of 150 km. The Vuokatti downhill skiing center opens the slopes normally in November.

In wintertime one can easily make all the "must do" Finnish snow activities (i.e. snowmobile and husky safaris, snowshoeing) in Vuokatti area. The aurora season starts in Vuokatti at the same time as everywhere else in Finland, in September when the nights become darker. The probability to see this natural phenomenon in Vuokatti is around 25% which means that if your vacation lasts one week you should see the aurora borealis at least once during your stay.

In summertime Vuokatti and the surrounding area suit ideally for a visitor who looks for the Finnish summer and nature activities such as hiking, fishing, canoeing, boating, wildlife watching or relaxing cottage life with the traditional Finnish sauna.

ALL YEAR ROUND

Vuokatti is the only Finnish resort offering all year round winter activities. The world's first skiing tunnel built in 1998 offers possibility to practice cross-country skiing all-year-round. Besides skiing, this is the place where you can try husky sledding and snowshoeing also in summertime. Check out the newest addition to the slope activities: in the shelter of a tunnel you'll find an all-year-round activity park with snow fun for the whole family, from downhill skiing, snowboarding and tubing to thrilling snow-filled activities for kids.

Families with children will definitely appreciate a visit to an indoor activity park, Superpark situated in Vuokatti or a relaxing time spent in the spa and sauna world in Holiday Club Spa Katinkulta.

CENTRE FOR SPORTS ENTHUSIASTS AND PROFESSIONALS

The development of Vuokatti as a holiday resort dates back to the 1940s when the Vuokatti Sport Institute started to function. Since then Vuokatti has become a favorite place for different sport teams of national and international level to camp and train in the area. The unique facilities, such as the ski tunnel, snow tunnel, ice arena, sport laboratory and other services have since long been recognized as the best place in Finland for the professionals. Therefore Vuokatti Sport has the status to be an official Olympic Training Center for the Nordic Skiing

disciplines. All these facilities are naturally available for leisure travelers who want to get a slightly more professional touch to their activities.

Another special group which Vuokatti suits ideally for is youth camp schools. The large scale of activities and accommodation facilities in the area are undoubtedly a big plus when schools are choosing the place for a study tour. Vuokatti offers interesting programs with emphasis to active nature experience, winter or summer sport or Finnish lifestyle.

LOCAL CULTURE

The unique geographical position of the province of Kainuu at the crossroad of Lapland and Lakeland reflects not only to the shape of the nature but also to the culture of this province. The proximity of the Russian border and Karelian culture gives to this combination an extra flavor and offers to the visitor a possibility to feel the Finnish lifestyle as its best.

TAR

Production of tar was one of the main sources of living in the province of Kainuu until the First World War. Kainuu area produced the main part of the tar in whole world. Tar was produced by slowly burning wood and the ready-made tar was transported to export in big barrels (125 liters) by the rivers and lakes which connect Kainuu area with the harbor of Oulu in the Gulf of Bothnia.

In Kajaani you can visit the old castle ruins from the 17th century and see the only functioning tar canal in the world. In summertime "tar rowing performances" take place in the canal. Additionally the Museum of the Kainuu province in Kajaani has a good exhibition unveiling the history of tar industry in Kainuu area. Tar is also an ingredient in the local culinary. Learn more under "Culinary experiences and specialties".

SOTKAMO

Sotkamo is the municipality where the resort of Vuokatti is situated. The Sotkamo center is situated some 7 km from Vuokatti and it only takes 5-10 minutes drive by car. The center is a typical modern Finnish municipality center with a good selection



of shops and other services. Just like everywhere else in Finland the most of the old wooden buildings in Sotkamo were unfortunately replaced by modern constructions starting from the 1960s and 1970s. A lot of old elegance of the Finnish towns and villages perished that time when the modern architecture was in the main stream. A historical scale model depicting Sotkamo center in 1939 can be seen in the local handicraft shop in Sotkamo center. The shop is situated on the second floor of the local K-Supermarket and it also offers also a large scale of authentic local souvenirs and handicraft.

Sotkamo has – surprisingly enough – one of the best sand beaches in Finland. The Hiukka beach by the Lake Sapsöjärvi in the Sotkamo center, often quoted as “the Riviera of Kainuu”, is a very popular and crowded place in a sunny summer day. Sunbath and a dip to fresh water on this great beach is a real Finrelax activity. In summertime you can also enjoy the services of the beach restaurant.

Just few steps away from the beach one can also find a large Finnish baseball arena. The local baseball team “Sotkamons Jymy” is one of the best teams in Finland and has won the national championship 18 times. In summertime baseball games of highest national league take place regularly at the local baseball arena.

CULINARY EXPERIENCES & SPECIALTIES

The great history of tar production is reflected also to the local culinary. In Kajaani the famous bakery of Pekka Heikkinen found in 1913 is baking tar flavored bread (tervaleipä in Finnish). The bread is sold in a few local shops, but a visit to the bakery shop and café of Pekka Heikkinen in Kajaani is a “must” when visiting this area.

In Vuokatti, Huuskola farm is manufacturing dairy products such as ice-creams and sorbets, cheeses, yogurts etc. One of the most exotic flavors of their home-made ice-creams is tar. You can buy Huuskola farm products in the local shops or visit their farm house café.

NAAPURINVAARA DANCE HALL

Naapurinvaara is one of the best dance halls of Finland — a place located next to the famous tourist centre of Vuokatti.

Open air dance places and dance pavilions

began to appear to the Finnish landscape in towns and villages starting from the second half of the 19th century. The peak of the popularity of open air dance places and dance pavilions in Finland was after the Second World War in the 40s and 50s when there were thousands of temporary and stable dancing places all over the country. Starting from the 60s the popularity and number of the dancing places started to diminish when new modern leisure activities such as television became more popular. However, a certain number of dance pavilions still remain in Finland and during the few past decades the popularity of social dances and dance pavilions is growing again.

The current pavilion was first built in 1959. Today the dancing evenings take place on Saturdays from March to November. There is always live music and a guesting popular Finnish artist or orchestra playing during the evening. Up to 2,000 - 4,000 people can visit the pavilion when the performing artist is popular enough. But every dancing evening is a piece of the deepest authentic Finnish culture. You can hear traditional melancholic and modern Finnish dance music, see a mass of people enjoying the rhythm of the dance and of course visiting the “buffet” – the bar offering drinks and small snacks.

From Naapurinvaara hilltop, an amazing view opens over the hill-flanked open lake waters of Southern Kainuu. On a clear day, it is possible to see all the way to the neighbouring provinces of North Karelia and Northern Savonia. Of course, Vuokatinvaara dominates the scenery.

NATIONAL PARKS IN KAINUU REGION

HIIDENPORTTI NATIONAL PARK

The canyons of Hiidenportti are an impressive sight. Along the path leading to the main gorge you can experience a shady spruce forest, a flowery meadow and woodland that used to be cleared periodically by slash-and-burn farmers. The park has many fascinating places and stories for anyone interested in cultural history to discover.

Distance from Vuokatti: 53 km

SERVICES FOR VISITORS

The Palolampi rental hut is available for hire for group meals. A nature information shelter, a cooking shelter, campfire sites and firewood, dry toilets.

HIKING TRAILS

There are almost 30 km of marked and duckboard covered trails in Hiidenportti National Park.

Circle Trails: Hiidenkierros Trail, 3-5 km, Kitulankierros Trail, 10.5 km.

TIILIKKAJÄRVI NATIONAL PARK

The park's lovely lakeshores include the beautiful beach of Venäjänhiekkä (Russian Sands), whose name relates to the 1595 Treaty of Teusina which divided these lands between Sweden and Russia. An old border stone in lake Tiilikkajärvi still bears a crown and a cross symbolising the two countries. A sandy esker ridge formation runs through the lake, adding to the varied natural scene. Slow down, relax, and enjoy a refreshing dip in the lake.

Tiilikkajärvi National Park was established to preserve wilderness-like lake, river and esker ecosystems, as well as, the open aapa bogs surrounding lake Tiilikka. The lake is about 4 km² in size. The humus-filled river Itkonjoki flows into lake Tiilikka after having passed through the parks mires. Lake Tiilikka has very few aquatic plants as the water is quite hard when it flows from the mires.

Distance from Vuokatti: 62 km

ACTIVITIES

Hiking: There are approximately 20 km of marked trails.

Skiing: The route is made up of two classic cross-country tracks (7 km and 17 km).

CAMPFIRE SITES

The park's campfire sites are located at Sammakkotammi, at Uiton kämpppä rental hut, at Koirakivi rock and at Koseva and Venäjänhiekkä camping sites.

Please note that lighting campfires is forbidden if the forest fire warning is in effect.

This prohibition does not apply to cooking shelters or other fireplaces with a flue.

HOSSA NATIONAL PARK

The magnificent wilderness of Hossa is an excellent destination: the trails running along pine heaths invite you to hike and cycle, and the crystal-clear lakes to go canoeing and fishing. The rock paintings of Julma-Ölkky and Värkallio depict stories of shamanism, dating back thousands of years.

The forests and waters of Hossa are easily accessible to visitors. There are a wide range of hiking and biking trails, and the waters invite you to go canoeing and fishing. On your trip, you will travel along the same routes as the area's first inhabitants did 10,000 years ago.

In the national park, you may also travel outside the trails, but it is advisable to move along the paths in order to avoid eroding the terrain. Please adhere to the national park's rules and the principles of litter-free hiking.

Distance from Vuokatti: 209 km

SERVICES FOR VISITORS

Hossa Visitor Centre (open from March to October), open wilderness huts, lean-to shelters, campfire sites and firewood, camping sites, camping grounds, rental huts, dry toilets.

Services provided by partners are available in the area. There is a café-restaurant at the Hossa Visitor Centre. You can prepare food at cabins, huts and rest spots.

HIKING

The marked trails are mainly easy (90 km) and they are suitable for day trips and for longer hikes. Fairly easy water routes (60 km).

CAMPFIRE SITES

Hossa National Park boasts 14 lean-to shelters and 5 open wilderness huts, next to which there is a campfire site.

Campfires are only allowed at designated campfire sites.

Making an open fire is forbidden when a forest fire warning is in effect.

This prohibition does not apply to cooking shelters or other fireplaces with a flue.

KAJAANI

Most visitors of Vuokatti arrive by plane to the airport of Kajaani (KAJ), also the nearest railway station to Vuokatti is situated in the city of Kajaani. The distance between the Kajaani city center and Vuokatti is only some 34 kilometers. The capital of the province of Kainuu is an ideal day trip destination from Vuokatti and there are a few local buses by day connecting Vuokatti with Kajaani.

Kajaani was founded in 1651 and around half of the whole population of the province of Kainuu now lives in Kajaani. The number of inhabitants is 37,000. The city center is compact and all the main objects of interest are situated in walking distance.

Kajaani has also a good selection of shops, shopping malls, restaurants and bars. In July the steamship Kouta, the northernmost steamship in Finland and whole Europe, makes regular cruises on the Lake Oulujärvi. Charter cruises on the steamship Kouta are available from June to September.

SIGHTS AND ATTRACTIONS

Kajaani Castle Ruins

The northernmost stone castle in the world.

Tar Canal

The only tar canal in the world, built in the 1840's. Situated by the castle ruins.

Churches

Lutheran & Orthodox churches in the city center. Paltaniemi Church (open in summertime).

Old City Hall

The old city hall in the centre is the oldest building in Kajaani.

Steamship Kouta

The steamship Kouta is the northernmost steamship in Finland and whole Europe. Enjoy the beautiful sceneries of lake Oulujärvi during lakeland cruises in summer. oulujarviristeilyt.fi

Museums

Museum of Kainuu region, Art Museum.

SHOPPING FACILITIES

The main shopping street in the city center is Kauppakatu.

Local handicrafts and design can be purchased at Kainuun Pirtti (Linnankatu 18, by the castle ruins).

CULINARY EXPERIENCES AND RESTAURANT SERVICES

Pekka Heikkinen: Bakery Café and Shop

Pekka Heikkinen offers local bread (including the one with tar flavor), sweet and savory pastries, cakes, chocolates and cookies. The Puu-uunileipä - a rye bread baked in a wood heated oven - is one of the most popular souvenirs.

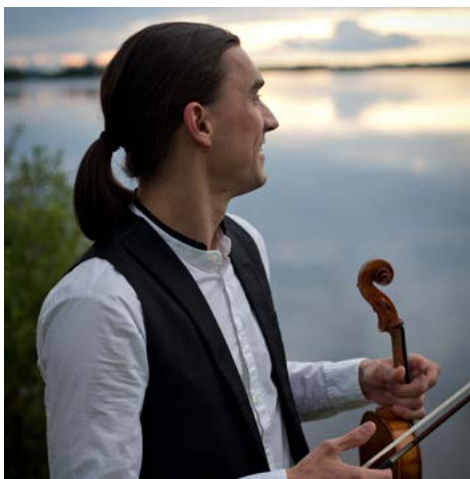

SKI TUNNEL

Vuokatti has the World's first indoor ski tunnel which was built in 1997. The Ski Tunnel is Vuokatti's one of the craziest innovations, which gained recognition all around the world. The aim of the ski tunnel is to create perfect conditions for the professional athlete's trainings on the natural snow in the summertime.

Nowadays Vuokatti Sport Resort also uses it for amazing activities such as husky safari, kicksled, skiing, group games and fun olympics in addition to one of its most important purposes as the main training venues.

High-standard conditions inside the tunnel allow skiing all year round. Air and snow conditions in the Ski Tunnel are maintained by using the latest computer technology. The temperature is maintained at -5 – -9 degrees, but if needed, it can be dropped to -18 degrees. The air renovation cycle is 4 hours and all the tracks are groomed by machines. The snow machines inside the Tunnel can also make new snow if needed.

There is one classical track on site for each skiing direction. The height difference (18 m) makes the terrain variable and enjoyable to ski - there are easy downhill as well as uphill during the 2.4 km round. Because of the temperature inside the Tunnel (-5 to -9 degree Celsius) it is preferable to wear proper clothing.



Additional advantage of the Ski Tunnel is that it also allows you the entrance to longer outdoor tracks from 10th October on and during coldest winter days makes it possible to enjoy skiing on comfortable circumstances.

HOTEL TULIKETTU

Hotel Tulikettu is situated in a naturally beautiful area of Sotkamo, Finland only a few kilometres from the famous Vuokatti holiday resort! A scenic view of the sandy beach of Lake Sapso and the hills of Vuokatti opens before your eyes from the hotel rooms and our restaurant.

Hotel Tulikettu is a family-owned hotel with a traditional, homelike atmosphere and comfortable rooms. Tulikettu stands at the top of a forested ridge, close to sandy Hiukka beaches and clean waters of Lake Sapso. Small shops and other services of Sotkamo municipal centre are just a few hundred meters walk away from the hotel.

Hotel Tulikettu is situated near versatile outdoor exercise facilities of Sotkamo and Vuokatti. Large network of Nordic skiing trails goes 200 m from the hotel. We have also facilities for our guests to maintenance their skiing equipment.

HOTEL ROOMS

Hotel Tulikettu has 82 homey non-smoking rooms. Some rooms have entrance to the backyard. There are also rooms where pets are allowed. Hotel has two suites with private saunas. Most of the rooms are for two persons but some of the larger rooms are fitted with extra beds for 3-4 persons.

Facilities: All rooms include basic hotel equipment (beds, TV, shower, restroom, minibar, etc.).

RESTAURANT

The hotel restaurant has over hundred customer places and a cocktail bar. The restaurant serves breakfast, lunch and à la carte dinner for its guests. Dishes with game meat and dishes with traditional Finnish ingredients (e.g. berries, mushrooms) delivered by local farms and retailers are the chef's specialties. BUS

GROCERY STORES

Vuokatti's K-Supermarket is located at Heikintie 1, 88610 Vuokatti and S-Market Vuokatti is situated at Katinkullantie 1, 88610 Vuokatti. At both stores, you will find a comprehensive range of groceries, as well as products from local producers. More grocery stores can be found 7 kilometres from Vuokatti, in the city of Sotkamo.

VUOKATTI PHARMACY

Everything you need for self-care can be found in the pharmacy, located in the same building as Vuokatti S-Market (Katinkullantie 1, 88610 Vuokatti), and open on weekdays. In Sotkamo, 7 kilometres from Vuokatti, you can find a pharmacy which is open also on weekends.

ALKO

The nearest Alko (the national alcohol beverage retailer) is located 7 kilometres from Vuokatti in the city of Sotkamo, in connection with the Sotkamo K-Supermarket (Kainuuntie 18, 88600 Vuokatti).

POST OFFICE

The Sotkamo post office serves customers in connection with the R-Kioski corner store chain in Sotkamo, 7 kilometres from Vuokatti (Kainuuntie 15, 88600 Sotkamo). Postage stamps can also be found in grocery stores and post boxes for sending mail are found throughout Vuokatti. You can often send post cards and letters also via the hotel reception.

EQUIPMENT RENTAL

You can rent skis or snowshoes from the cross country ski specialist Vuokatti Ski Service. The professional staff will help you choose proper equipment: suited for your skill level, and always properly maintained and waxed according to the weather conditions. You can also rent Fatbike bicycles all year round from Ski Service. (Opistontie 9c, 88610 Vuokatti). GoVuokatti's cross-country skiing equipment are available for rent at Vuokatti Bowling (Katinkullantie 11, 88610 Vuokatti) and from Vuokatti Slope Rental Shop you can rent equipment for cross country skiing, downhill skiing and snowboarding (Veikontie 3, 88610 Vuokatti).

BEAR WATCHING

Meet the Finnish national animal, the bear, in Kuhmo with Vuokatti Safaris and its Bear Watching Evening tour. Bears are Europe's biggest predators and the male bear can weigh up to 300 kg. Transport from Vuokatti to the bear hideout leaves in the afternoon and returns to Vuokatti in the evening, with the magical evening lasting about nine hours.
